Róbert Hecker: The authokeirical motivations—and visions—mediation as the task of the counseling and church leadership.

The Main Thesis of the Research Program

- 1) The essence of well defined leadership is not the leadership position, but rather the willingness to take responsibility. Our future and that of our churches depend upon the measure to which we encourage and teach this to each other.
- 2) The willingness of leadership to take responsibility takes shape through practical activities of counseling and community building. In this atmosphere, the group being led will function well.
- 3) The well functioning group can be open to accepting and following a Holy Spirit directed divine inspiration. The leader that is open to inspiration serves as the mediator between divine inspiration and those with whom he is entrusted.
- 4) The uniqueness of leader mediated inspiration is that it becomes an inspiration that motivates the entire group. Investigation is key to this process.
- 5) The quality of the leadership model does not derive its results from the greatness of the achievements; rather it depends on the group's maintenance, continual development and progres
