The HUNOR (HUNGarian Open Repositories) consortium was established in 2008 by the libraries of Hungarian higher education institutions and the Library of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences to advance national open access practices. The members of HUNOR are dedicated to promoting Hungarian research both nationally and internationally and to achieving effective dissemination of scientific outputs through the implementation of a national infrastructure of open access repositories. Other activities include the operation of a methodology center, adopting international know-how and standards, the establishment of complementary scientific communication channels, and international relations. HUNOR is coordinated by the National and University Library of the University of Debrecen.

HUNOR focuses on disseminating online information on OA-related issues in Hungarian and offering consultancy for all stakeholders in the country. HUNOR aims to preserve its function as a methodology center and a national and international contact point in new aspects of scholarly communication.
